COVID SAFE SETTINGS (Published 17 Jan

Pre-Trial 2022)

- Make sure you are fully vaccinated against COVID and that you have linked you vaccination certificate to your Services Victoria Check in App. If you don't have a smart phone or would just like to ensure you have a hard copy in case of technology issues, please print a hard copy of your certificate.
- If you are under 12 and cannot be vaccinated, please bring proof of age document
- If you are 12 or older and cannot be vaccinated, you will be required to have lodged a vaccination exemption with the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) via your Medical Practitioner. The AIR will then provide a certificate which you can then link to your Services Victoria Check in App and you can also print out a hard copy.
- If you are exposed to COVID or if you develop COVID symptoms, please test and isolate according to the Public Health Directions and notify the trial secretary.
- If you are unwell, please do not attend the trial.

On Arrival at the trial site

You must check in prior to unpacking and setting up crating areas. You must have completed
QR code check in, had your vaccination status verified before you can move about the trial
location. At check in you will receive a wrist band to wear for the day. Everyone must
check-in without exception. Family members and friends must also check in.

COVID Safe practises you must adhere to whilst at the trial:

- Always carry a facemask on your person. It is not mandatory outdoors but you must still carry one in case you cannot social distance. At this stage masks are mandatory indoors so a mask must be worn inside the arena and toilet blocks. You may remove your mask indoors to eat/drink. You may remove your mask for each run with your dog. The Judge may remove their mask if required to ensure exhibitors hear instructions. If mask settings change an update will be published on the website.
- Please sanitise your hands frequently during the day. You must sanitise before and after touching agility equipment and before and after performing any rostered job.
- Please always maintain social distancing. If you cannot social distance, please wear your mask. Course walk throughs cannot guarantee social distancing so you must wear a mask.
- Please cover your nose and mouth when coughing/sneezing and then sanitise.

Post Trial

• If you become ill with COVID symptoms, test positive or get notification of exposure please advise NADAC Australia immediately in case your situation requires a NADAC response to protect others who attended the trial with you.
