

SHOW INSTRUCTIONS 4 July 2020

Dear Exhibitor,

How exciting that we are back playing agility albeit with some restrictions and new procedures to follow to be covid safe. The following information is to assist you to be aware and have all the information to enjoy your day with your dog(s).

COVID-19

- If you are ill and have respiratory symptoms please stay at home and as recommended by Government Health Officials go and have a COVID-19 screening test. Contact me to let me know. (NB if you share a household/have close contact with a person who is ill, has confirmed or suspected covid-19 you too should be self isolating)
- If you reside in any of the lockdown postcodes you must not attend this trial and should withdraw immediately and contact me.
- Without a risk waiver and health declaration you will not be permitted to be on trial site.
- No spectators (sorry but family members and friends have to stay at home for now.
- If you choose not to work from your car and want to set up a crating area – all gazebos must be spaced at least 1.5 meters apart.
- Social distancing and hand hygiene is a MUST – we need your help and commitment to this throughout the trial.

VENUE LOCATION

We are directly opposite the Wings Café at Moorabbin airport. In between the Airport museum and the fair share garden. BTW the Wings café is closed.

Those setting up the mesh should arrive at 6.30am. Those unloading the trailer should be at the trailer by no later than 6.45am

TRIAL START TIME

Walk through for the first course of the day will commence at 7.50am. We will be asking you not to group in the marshalling area on mass but rather line up single file with 1.5 metres between each person. We will ask that each person allow the person in front one sequence headstart before entering the course. Walk the course in flow and direction of the course. Maintain social distance at all times. We may split walk throughs into smaller groups if need be.

The main public toilet block is located in the car park area at the end of Second Avenue , Bundora Road side opposite the Air Academy <https://goo.gl/maps/9bJWMzu6RqpCbMd96>

Toilets are also available in the airport museum next to the trial ground. The museum opens at 10am but may have different hours due to covid-19. It was open yesterday when I went to mark the ground 😊 Enter the museum via the main door only advise staff you are with the dog group and on your first visit give a gold coin donation. Follow all directions of the museum staff as they may have limits on number of people in the building due to covid.

Whichever facility you use take your own hand hygiene kit for your own health and wellbeing.

Results will not be printed or posted onsite during the trial – we do not want gatherings around results to occur.

I will be posting them directly onto the NADAC Australia website calendar page against the trial listing at regular intervals throughout each day. They will also be emailed to you at the end of each day.

PRESENTATIONS

There will be no end of day presentations to avoid gathering of people. Highest in Trial winners will be announced on the website, facebook and via email.

Highest in Trial Certificates will be emailed to the winners along with a \$5.00 trial entry credit note voucher to use at future NADAC trials.

We encourage exhibitors to accept trial credits in place of ribbons but this not a requirement. Should a person want ribbons and we fully understand that these are precious to mark certain milestones with your dog, please see me at the end of the trial day to collect them directly from me. If you don't come to collect ribbons you will automatically receive trial credits via email.
